



EBNJ Covid-19 Re-opening Directives

EBNJ would like to reopen and return to our normal in-person church activities in September 2021. However, to save lives and stop the spread of COVID-19, we would like to have at least a 70% full vaccination rate among our church members. We are asking for every eligible church member to help us reach this important objective. If you are not vaccinated and have questions and concerns, we strongly encourage that you contact your doctor or health professional to discuss your options. If you need to be vaccinated, please contact EBNJ Health Ministry to help you schedule an appointment as soon as possible.

EBNJ Reopening Directives

1. Stay Home, IF:

- You have tested positive for COVID-19
- Showing COVID-19 symptoms
- Waiting for a test result
- Have not yet been cleared to discontinue isolation
- Have had contact with a person who had COVID-19 or COVID-19 symptoms within the last 14 days.

2. Use of Masks

- The use of masks over both the mouth and nose is required at all times.
- If you have trouble breathing while wearing a mask, please choose to stay home.

3. Physical Distancing and Healthy Etiquette

- Follow the directives of the ushers and health volunteers when entering and exiting the church building.
- Follow social and physical distancing protocol when entering, exiting the church building, and while seated.
- Limit your stay in the common areas, lobby, and restrooms.
- Contact EBNJ Health Ministry immediately if you test positive for COVID-19 after attending service.
